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SBDM Meeting Minutes
July 17, 2014 - BCHS Library

Members in Attendance: Mark Raleigh, Marty Steele, Alison Sutton, Jennifer Ensley

1. Opening Business

A) Agenda for tonight's meeting was reviewed & accepted. Jennifer Ensley motioned to accept the agenda, seconded by Marty Steele. Consensus.

B) Minutes from June 18, 2014 meeting were reviewed & amended as follows:
In section 3. third paragraph to read "Beginning with the Class of 2017, students will have 5 years to meet graduation requirements for accountability purposes." Motion to accept Minutes as amended was made by Alison Sutton, seconded by Marty Steele, consensus.

C) Good News Reports – BCHS Junior, Trey Ganns was named Baseball Player of the Year. That makes BCHS students "athletes of the year" in baseball, soccer, bowling and softball. The building construction is progressing and will be completed prior to the Schedule Pick Up days.

2. Student Achievement

A) Review of 2014 Advanced Placement Data (handout)

Overall, AP scores were not good with the exception of U.S. History and Art. There was discussion of the discrepancy in grades students are earning in these AP classes and their performances on the actual AP exams. There appears to be a disconnect between instruction and testing. This disconnect needs to be addressed.

3. Planning

A) Monthly Review – Understanding by Design (UbD) – Boone County School District is buying a UbD program. A select group of teachers will be trained on UbD, probably in about 4 different sessions this year. Those teachers will then train the other teachers here at BCHS. Mr. Schlotman and Mr. Neuhaus are planning our New Teacher Orientation to take place on August 6, to ease these teachers' transition to our school.

4. Budget Report – Members received two reports from Ms. Ryan – June Report plus End of Year Report. Motion to accept Budget Reports was made by Jennifer Ensley, seconded by Alison Sutton, consensus.

5. Personnel – Interviews have continued for the Staff Support position in the Front Office. One candidate was lost to Kenton County School District. As of today, the position has been

offered to Ms. Janet High. She has many years experience in Illinois schools as a front office secretary. Mr. Raleigh recommends her for hire.

Council moved to Special Session to discuss the following personnel related items. Cindy Wallace who has worked for several years in our Special Education Dept. will return to the Business Dept. to fill the position left with the retirement of Rick Thompson. Karen Witemyre is an internal transfer to fill the position in our Special Education Dept. There is still one Special Education position to be filled. Patty Mueller is the new Ladies Golf Coach, and several positions with the Football program are still open.
